TOXIC WASTE

Products such as paints, detergents, or others must be taken to the collection center in Aigle where an appropriate room is available. In case of high toxicity, please contact CRIDEC in Eclépens, phone number: 021 866 03 00.

VARIOUS MEDICATIONS

These should be returned to pharmacies.

ORDINARY HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Collection occurs twice a week. Official bags should be placed in designated collection spots, cabins, and containers.

Official bags can be purchased at general stores in Gryon and Barboleuse, at SAS Alpe des Chaux, at the Tourism Office, at the municipal office, and at major retailers in the Canton.

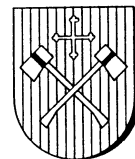
Families with newborns may receive a certain number of free bags, as well as those with heavy medical care. Please contact the municipal office.

Controls will be carried out on unofficial bags, and offenders will be fined.

FOOD WASTE

Food waste can be deposited in the 6 GastroVert collection points using a red magnetic card, which also provides access to the recycling center.

RATES FOR SPECIAL DEPOSITS

Incinerables (except for polluting waste)	fr. 15.-/ m3
Grass, lawn, branches	fr. 15.-/ m3
Earthy, gravel, and inert waste	fr. 30.-/ m3
Car tires without rims	fr. 10.- / pc
Large truck and machine tires	fr. 25.- /pc
Batteries	fr. 10.- /pc

These fees are paid in cash or by prepaid deposit card worth CHF 100 or CHF 400, available at the municipal office.

REMINDER: Access to the municipal recycling center is strictly reserved for cardholders.

Accepted at the municipal recycling center



Grass, lawn, branches should be deposited in the designated area or as per the supervisor's instructions. A deposit fee will be charged for any deposits exceeding 1m³. **Apart from individual composting, it is strictly prohibited to deposit these materials outside the designated center.**



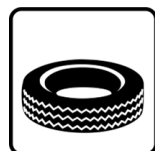
Large ferrous and metal waste (steel, cast iron, etc.) should be deposited in the designated container.



Paper and cardboard should be sorted separately, according to available bins. Additionally, a **collection** takes place every two months, according to the dates listed here.



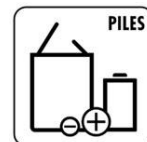
A bin is available for all incinerable waste such as wood, mattresses, clothes, Styrofoam, plastics, etc. These are bulky items with a volume or diameter greater than 60 cm and must not have contained food. Furniture must be disassembled. Collection takes place on the dates listed on page 1. For specific collections for people with mobility issues, please contact the external services at phone number: 024 498 00 97.



Tires must be deposited with payment at the designated spot. They will be deflated. The easiest way is to have them taken by the garage that sold the new tires.



Household appliances, computers, fridges are accepted free of charge and should be deposited on the pallets provided or as directed by the supervisor. All retailers selling these items are obligated to take them back.



Batteries should be primarily returned to sales points, but they can also be deposited in the designated bins.



Glass of all colors, not sorted, should be placed in containers designated for that purpose at various collection points. Glass must be free of foreign objects.

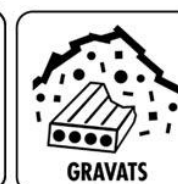


Special containers are available at the collection center for vegetable oils (peanut, olive, etc.) and mineral oils (engine oils). There is no need to separate them. Oils and fats should never be disposed of via toilets.



Electronic cigarettes (vapes) can be deposited in the designated collection box. Recycling bags can be ordered by users via www.vape-recycler.ch for free postal return. All distributors are obligated to take them back.

Are also admitted :



Demolition waste containing asbestos is not accepted at the recycling center, but small amounts of specific waste such as flowerpots or corrugated sheets can be deposited. These must be wrapped in plastic and handled with care.
